


Browsing Classification Information

Depending on your configuration, you can view Classification Levels of pages in a tabular interface at:

- Profile Level - See pages you have collaborated on and what their Classification Level is.
- Space Level - Browse page classification information at the Space-level.
- Administration Level - Browse all page classifications and manage the whitelist.
- Page Level - The level is always shown on a page at the top.
